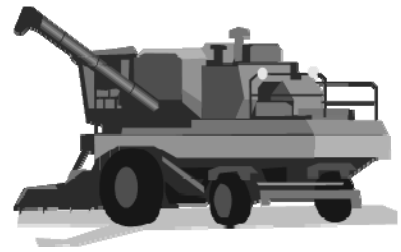


Fulton County Fair Combine Demolition Derby September 8, 2010 - 7:30 PM



Entry forms must be mailed to the Fulton County Fair Secretary, Jeanne Johnson, 18655 County Rd RS, Fayette, OH 43521. Entry fee must of \$15.00 sent with the form. No personal checks. Please make payment by cash, bank check or money order only and enclose a self addressed, stamped envelope with entry form.

Combine and Driver Rules

1. Competition will be limited to the first 25 entries. Derby will consist of five heats with five combines per heat. A feature heat will follow.
2. Do not bring your combine to the fairgrounds until the pit gate opens at 2:00 PM, September 8. Combines must be ready for inspection by 5:00 PM. Enter Gate B, north of main gate to Fairgrounds; go through track gate into the infield.
3. Each driver will purchase a gate pass or have a Season Ticket to the Fulton County Fair and a Pit Pass. Drivers must be at least 18 years of age and show proof of age. Gate Admission: \$5.00. Pit Pass: \$10.00.
4. Any person entering the infield must sign insurance release and waiver. No more than four members in each pit crew. Any driver or crew member not obeying rules will be disqualified. Drivers are responsible for the actions of their crew members.
5. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the infield and pit area. A violation by any crew member means a disqualification of combine. Coolers will be inspected.
6. A mandatory drivers meeting will be held 30 minutes prior to the derby. Fair reserves the right for any rule changes at that time. Official's decisions are Final.
7. Drivers must wear seat belt and helmet with face shield. Unit will be disqualified if the grain head does not remain on the combine.
8. Any size combine will be allowed. Combines may be placed in heats according to size. Grain table is not to exceed 16' and be fixed at 18" above the ground with the hydraulic hoses disconnected. Weld auger at the end of the tube only. Place a 3/8" safety cable with two clamps around the middle of the auger and through the floor to hold the auger in place.
9. Combine grain table must have reel, guards, and loose sheet metal removed. Combine ladder, unloading auger and fins on straw chopper must be removed. Separator must be inoperable. Driver's door must be welded or chained shut.
10. All combines must have cabs with safety bar across front of cab with as much protective steel around the cab as desired. Cab glass must be removed. Cab reinforcement recommended.
11. Fuel tank must be mounted in grain tank and batteries mounted in an area on top of the combine.
12. Combine tires can be filled with air only, no fluid allowed. No reinforced rims. No dual wheels or valve stem protectors allowed. **OIL AND FUEL MAY NOT BE DRAINED ON THE GROUND.**
13. All combines to be as originally manufactured. No reinforced parts, shields, or welding. Reinforcement of grain head allowed with a maximum of two pieces of 2 1/2" x 1/4" angle iron from the feeder house to the back of the grain table.

14. Combines may be decorated, painted or offer advertising. No profanity or obscene materials will be allowed. Cash premium of \$100 will be awarded for best appearing combine.
15. No pit racing allowed. Combines will not be allowed to run during any grandstand show.
16. Drivers of combines have a maximum of two minutes to make an aggressive hit.
17. No direct hits to the driver's area. No hits allowed when opponents combine is out of bounds or caught on the sidewall blocks.
18. Drivers of combines are not allowed to lift the wheels of another combine off the ground.
19. All combine motion must be halted upon signal from flaggers and announcers in case of fire, injury or other emergency.
20. A stick will be mounted in the vicinity of the operator. The stick must be broken when the driver is disqualified.
21. Heat winning combines will be placed in a holding area and cannot be worked on until the final heat winner is in the pit area. Drivers will be allowed 20 minutes to have combines ready for the final feature heat. No more than five people per combine in holding area. Complete list of pit crew must be turned in at driver's meeting.
22. Cash premiums of \$375 will be awarded each participating entrant. Each heat winner will receive \$100. The feature heat winner will receive additional \$250 prize money. Best of Show Award of \$100 announced at completion of the program. Checks will be awarded following removal of combine from fairgrounds. **All combines must be removed by Saturday, September 11, 2010.**
